Arts Education Partnership

What the West Valley Arts Council Offers:

- Draft and create an Arts Education Plan (Valued at \$10,000)
- Develop, plan and / or provide Professional Development for classroom teachers or art and music teachers - Council liaison(s) come out to the District, school or identified venue for up to 8 Professional Development, trainings, and / or planning meetings (Valued at \$10,000)
 - Workshops that can be offered:
 - Developing a collective Arts Education Plan
 - Grant Writing Assistance - where to find the grants plus how to write a good grant
 - Assessment preparation
 - Integrating the arts into general education (*Math, Reading, Writing, etc*)
 - Assistance with developing and promoting the arts to build community outreach and relations
 - Tax Credit writing strategies to increase donations for after school art/ music programs and / or field trips
 - Ensuring arts educators are incorporating State Standards into class preparation
- Invitation to two Inter District Art/Music all day conferences for teachers to: discuss arts education plans, hear from State Arts Education Representative and ask questions, hear from guest speaker(s), and learn about best practices for teaching and advocating for the arts in your community
- Invitation to two art and music mixers per year – meet and get to know art and music teachers from other area districts and schools, learn what they are doing as well as programs and projects they have worked on and fundraisers they have held
- Promotion of District and school arts and music main events and concerts on West Valley Arts Council Website
- Reduced cost to attend Arts Advantage performance series (4 shows a year)
 - Non Title I School: \$3.00 per student, per show (Savings of \$7.00 per ticket)
 - Title I School: \$1.50 per student, per show (Savings of \$8.50)
- Involvement in The Big Read literary arts program
- Access to data base of music and art teachers, camps, tutors and opportunities
- Invitation to all West Valley art shows (Minimum: 8 a year)
- Assistance with setting up summer and vacation art and music camps
- Opportunities for students to volunteer and to share their art talents
- Partner with WVAC on annual campaign drive to help raise funding for additional music and art programs throughout the West Valley
